About This One-Day Class: This personalized 4-hour course with professional photographer Lynne Brown, will help you master your camera and take great photographs. The class walks you through your camera's functions and features what they can do to improve your images. Participants will also learn the basics of composition and what makes for strong images. We will continue class and discussion through a brown bag lunch at the Township Hall, then put into practice what was learned by taking an excursion to a nearby park with our cameras.

1. **General Camera and Lens Overview** (exploring the different types of cameras and lenses (DSLR, mirrorless, point and shoot, phone camera etc.)
2. **Exposure Basics** (metering, aperture, shutter speed, ISO settings) what do they all mean? What these things do to help improve my photography?
3. **Composition**
 - Viewpoints and perspective
 - How do we use contrast, color, textures
 - Rule of Thirds
 - Composition for portraiture and landscapes

What to Bring: Your camera (lenses), comfortable walking shoes, comfortable clothing appropriate for the weather of the day. A brown bag lunch. A card reader for your camera's images or a way to download images for review and the desire to have a lot of fun!
