

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE PROPOSAL
Williamstown Township, Ingham County, Michigan
Resolution No. 2020 – _____

WHEREAS, the Williamston Area Senior Center is a private nonprofit corporation providing senior citizen services, programs and activities in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes as authorized by the Michigan Constitution and laws, including providing senior citizen services as authorized by MCL 400.571, *et seq*, and other applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board proposes to levy .25 mil for four (4) years (2020 through 2023) to support the Williamston Area Senior Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township Board resolves to approve the following millage proposal and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the November 2020 election ballot:

Proposal for Senior Center Millage

Shall Williamstown Township impose an increase of up to .25 mills (\$.25 per\$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec.6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 4 years, 2020 through 2023, inclusive, for local operation, improvement and maintenance purposes of the Senior Center, which .25 mill increase will raise an estimated \$66,325 in the first year the millage is levied.
