

WILLIAMSTOWN TOWNSHIP

BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

March 8, 2017 Synopsis

The Williamstown Township Board of Trustees held its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on March 8, 2017 at 7:03 p.m. with Supervisor Bloomquist, Treasurer Cutshaw, Clerk Steinberg, and Trustees Williams, Kane, Duffy, and Eyster present. The Board approved the consent agenda, consisting of the minutes from the February 28, 2017 special meeting (2017-2018 budget hearing), treasurer's report, revenue and expenditure report, police report, pending litigation, accounts payable paid, accounts payable for approval, payroll paid, and building inspector's report. The Board took the following actions: 1) asked the Township Planning Commission to update Zoning Ordinance definitions for consistency with the Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act (MCL 333.27101); 2) approved a budget for 2017-2018; 3) declined the Compensation Commission's recommendations on board member salaries for 2017-2018 (as a result, salaries are unchanged); 4) approved an ecological burn in the Township park; 5) approved a sale of firearms; 6) approved Resolution #114-2017 expressing concern over the recent reductions in CATA services for area residents; 7) approved a Board meeting schedule for 2017-2018; 8) approved Resolution # 2017-98 confirming the 2017 Special Assessment Roll for Police Protection; and 9) and tabled action on the proposed sign regulations to the April 5 meeting. The next Board meeting is April 5, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Hall.
